3. Application to the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Alberta

Licensed Practical Nurse Accreditation Process

Licensed Practical Nurses (LPNs) are professional nurses whose primary focus is in patient care. LPNs serve individuals, families, and groups, assessing their needs and providing care and treatment as appropriate. LPNs care for patients in hospitals, long-term nursing homes, health centers, doctor's offices, and teach within healthcare and the profession. LPNs have the knowledge and the skill to work as a member of the healthcare team, working with Registered Nurses, Doctors, Nursing Assistants and other healthcare professionals.

Obtaining Accreditation in Alberta:

Internationally Educated Nurses must graduate from an approved Practical Nurse program and register with the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Alberta (CLPNA) to practice as a LPN in Alberta.

1. To begin the accreditation process, internationally educated LPN's must contact one of the following colleges for an assessment of prior learning:

Colleges recommend that applicants contact them directly, in person or by telephone, to receive assistance with the application process.

Depending on individual qualifications and English language ability, Internationally Educated Nurses will be referred to the appropriate program at Bow Valley College and NorQuest College.

Program options are:

- NorQuest College:**
 - Practical Nurse Refresher Program for Internationally Educated Nurses or
 - Practical Nurse Diploma for Internationally Educated Nurses (for individuals who do not meet English language admission requirements)

- Bow Valley College:**
 - Practical Nurse Diploma for Internationally Educated Nurses program or
 - Integrated Practical Nurse Diploma for Internationally Educated Nurses (English as a Second language ESL) – for individuals who do not meet English language admission requirements

2. After successful completion of one of the programs listed above, the student is eligible to apply for licensure with the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Alberta (CLPNA). At this stage, the CLPNA will ask applicants to submit the following items:

- Application Form and Fee (\$600 – includes registration and application for enrollment to write the Canadian Practical Nurse Registration Examination [CPNRE])
- Personal Declaration
- Verification of program completion from Bow Valley College or NorQuest College
- A photocopy of a birth certificate and one piece of government issued photo identification that shows your complete legal name
- Official transcripts from completed LPN and/or Registered Nurse education programs at Bow Valley College or NorQuest College. Transcripts should be provided directly from the educational institutions, but original documents may be submitted.

If candidates have met the requirements list above, a “Temporary” Practice Permit will be issued.

3. Upon successful completion of the CPNRE, the LPN will become fully licensed with an “Active” Practice Permit. The CPNRE can be written three times a year (in May, September and January) and includes 250 multiple-choice questions in two sections of 125 questions. Candidates are given three chances to pass this exam.

Exceptions: LPNs Registered in the United States

Any individual living in the United States currently licensed as a LPN is eligible to apply directly to the CLPNA (without having to write the CPNRE) if they have:

- Graduated from a nursing program approved by a State Board of Nursing, or
- Graduated as an Internationally Educated Nurse and have 500 LPN practice hours in the U.S. over two years preceding an application for registration with the CLPNA.
- Achieved registration with a State Board of Nursing and have successfully passed the National Council Licensure Examination – Practical Nurse (NCLEX-PN).

Fees (excluding U.S. applicants):

The following CLPNA fees are in place for International Applicants. All fees are quoted in Canadian dollars, and must be submitted with your application.
